



2016 YOUTH TURKEY HUNTING RULES FOR LAKE LA SU AN WILDLIFE AREA



- Interested youth-turkey hunters are invited to attend the drawing at the **Lake La Su An Wildlife Area Headquarters, located at 09-455 Road R, Pioneer, Ohio**, Saturday, March 19, 2016. Registration begins at 9:30 a.m. and the drawing will begin at 10 a.m.
- Youth hunters 17 years of age and younger may enter the drawing for a permit to hunt the Lake La Su An Wildlife Area during the youth and regular spring wild turkey seasons.
- Youth hunters must bring a valid hunting license to register. **Youth hunters are not required to be present to participate. Adults may register a youth with the youth's valid hunting license.**
- Hunters will place a registration card in a drum, and names will be drawn for a 3-day, 4-day, or 5-day hunt permit, depending on the hunt period.
- As names are drawn, that hunter will pick their preferred hunt period and section that they wish to hunt.
- Names will be drawn until all hunt periods and sections are taken; 56 dates/sections are available for this year.
- Each hunt permit is valid for one licensed youth hunter. Hunters can only hunt during their designated hunt period and in the section stated on their permit.
- Youth permit holders must sign the hunt permit before entering the wildlife area to hunt.
- Permits are transferable, as long as the instructions on the back of the permit are followed.
- All turkey hunting regulations apply as stated in the Ohio Hunting & Trapping Regulations.
- Young hunters whose names are drawn must also possess a valid spring turkey permit before hunting.
