Dear Youth Hunt Participant:

Congratulations you have been selected to participate in the youth deer hunt on Salt Fork State Park the weekend of November 19th & 20th, 2016. Each participant was selected for **only one** of the two days.

Enclosed you will find your permit and a map showing the area of the park open for hunting during this season. Deer of either sex may be taken with a limit of two deer per hunter, only one of which may be antlered. Selected youth hunters must be accompanied by a non-hunting adult at all times. Shotguns using slugs or muzzle-loading rifles may be used.


Please pay special attention to your surroundings while hunting in the park area. Remember, there may be other youth hunters close by as well as other people using the park. Stay 400 feet away from the golf course and any roads, parking lots, camp sites, buildings and shelters. **DO NOT** hunt on or along a hiking trail. Please use designated parking areas.

If you are unable to participate on the date for which you have been selected, the permit is transferable to another youth hunter.
