**Job Title:** Conservation Worker (Waterfowl and Upland Wildlife Monitoring), Ohio DNR Division of Wildlife [20058810; 20058812]

**Description:** Two (2) SEASONAL CONSERVATION WORKERS are needed April-September 2015 to provide support for a variety of research and monitoring activities in Ohio. Duties will include trapping and banding of wood ducks, mallards, and mourning doves; conducting habitat/vegetation surveys; conducting surveys of grassland passerines, ruffed grouse, pheasants, and quail; preparation of maps using GIS; data entry; and other duties as assigned. Unusual work schedules and over-night travel are necessary for these positions. **QUALIFICATIONS:** Ideal candidates will have a familiarity with field identification of waterfowl and grassland birds; experience or training in a variety of waterfowl capture & handling techniques; use of ArcGIS to produce maps; accurate recording of data; and the ability to work early, long hours in unpleasant conditions (heat/humidity, biting insects, etc.).
