## WILDLIFE FIELD GUIDE SERIES

This series of 14 guides, including two aquatic guides, is an excellent addition to any lesson that focuses on the wide variety of wildlife and habitat that is found in the state.

### COMMON BIRDS OF OHIO 5414

A field guide of 103 common birds in Ohio accompanied by a CD depicting their calls.

### WARBLERS OF OHIO 5349

A publication as well as a CD of calls dedicated to the 50 different warblers that visit our state.

### OWLS OF OHIO 5423

This booklet and CD are devoted to the 22 various owls that inhabit or visit Ohio throughout the year.

### WATERBIRDS OF OHIO 5418

A booklet and CD with 138 species of birds that can be seen in Ohio's wetlands and other aquatic habitats.

### DRAGONFLIES AND DAMSELFLIES OF OHIO 5320

A guide with photos and descriptions of 55 species of dragonflies and damselflies found in Ohio.

### AMPHIBIANS OF OHIO 5348

This guide colorfully depicts the state's 38 salamanders, toads, and frogs.

A booklet that illustrates 44 species of reptiles including turtles, lizards, and snakes.



## PROJECT WILD

Project WILD is an interdisciplinary environmental education program with an emphasis on wildlife. Materials include the K-12 guide, Aquatic WILD K-12 guide, Growing Up WILD guide for pre-K, and the Science and Civics guide for High School. ## WILDLIFE POSTER SETS

The Division of Wildlife regularly produces posters for special events and projects. Surpluses of these posters are made available to educators as supplies last. Orders may include some of these posters in addition to the regular offerings listed below.

### WILDLIFE HISTORY TIMELINE POSTER

A two-sided poster that looks at habitat and wildlife and the events that changed them from 1803-2003. Includes a hands-on activity that can bring the timeline to life for your students.



### INSECTS OF OHIO POSTER

This two-sided poster beautifully illustrates 26 common insect species on the front and life history information on the back.

### CATERPILLARS OF OHIO POSTER

This two-sided poster illustrates the unique and notable caterpillars of 30 species of moths and butterflies found in Ohio.

### ADDITIONAL POSTER SETS

Depending on available quantities, educators will receive a set of three or more Smokey Bear posters featuring groups of animals, such as mammals, birds, reptiles, etc. Selection is dependent on current supplies.

## AQUATIC EDUCATION PROGRAMS & MATERIALS
