



## Guidelines for Use of the Tri-Valley WA Field Trial Facility

Facility Address: 2814 Stone Church Road, Dresden, Ohio 43821

**Obtaining Key** - The keys for both the gate and service center will be kept in a lock box located on the back of the meter by the water well near the entrance gate to the field trial area. When the approved application is issued, the code for the combination lock on the lock box will be provided.

**Maps/Aerial Photos** - Located immediately inside the entry door of the service building.

**Parking Area Use** - All vehicles, campers, trailers, etc. **must** be parked in the designated and stoned parking areas. Parking space is limited. **Field trial clubs are expected to police their group's parking and ensure that all vehicles are not parked on the grass.** Maximize parking space and be considerate of others when parking. **All** manure is to be removed from the parking area and placed in the designated Manure Storage Area.

**Vehicle Use** – All vehicles must be kept in the designated parking and stoned areas. No vehicles are allowed on the grounds or the access roads. ATV use is not permitted in the wildlife area.

**Service Center** – Upon conclusion of each event, the Service Center shall be cleaned, swept, and the trash deposited in the two designated receptacles. **Any other trash that does not fit in these receptacles should be taken with you.** Before vacating the building, all lights should be turned off, all windows and doors closed and locked. The thermostat should be turned off or set to the lowest setting.

**Horse Use** - Horses are for field trial purposes only. Horses are not to be outside of the designated field trial area. Horses or dogs are not to be tied, secured or otherwise be in contact, with the service building, or any oil and gas wells or associated equipment.

**Horse Corral** - The corrals are available on a first-come basis. Horses may be staked in the unmowed portion of the grounds. **Do not stake horses in the stoned parking areas.** Corrals are to be cleaned after each event. Manure is to be deposited in the designated Manure Storage Area.

**Dog Kennels** - Kennel space is on a first-come basis. **Do not stake dogs in the stoned parking areas.** At the end of the event, kennels are to be cleaned and hosed down in preparation for the next event. Manure is to be deposited in the designated Manure Storage Area.

**Manure Deposition** - Manure is to be placed in the designated Manure Storage Area only. This area is available for manure from dogs and horses as it accumulates in and around the parking area, kennels, corrals, and service building. The Manure Storage Area **is not** for cleaning out horse trailers.

**Field Trial Report Form** - Blank report forms are located immediately inside the service building. Please complete and sign the form. Leave it in the box located in the closet of the service building with the facility and gate keys or return it to the District office within 30 days after the event. The report form should be completed by a club representative, ideally the same one that requested the field trial permit.

**Note:** Other approved uses of this wildlife area are permitted during the field trial seasons and all field trial events. If an unauthorized use is observed, feel free to contact the Wildlife Officer for assistance (see below for numbers).
