

# 2012-2013 Beaver/Otter Trapping Lottery Application

**Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid hunting license and fur taker permit.**

The ODNR, Division of Wildlife is conducting the 3rd annual permitted trapping events for beaver and otter (where allowed) on publicly-managed areas, where beaver trapping is not otherwise allowed.

The permits issued from this lottery event are for beaver and otter in counties where otter trapping is allowed, except where noted.

**The application period is September 15 through October 15.**

**NOTE:** Applicants must hold a current hunting license in order to apply for this trapping lottery. Applications submitted by people who are not properly licensed will be returned along with all application fees.

- Participation is determined by random drawings.
- The application fee is \$3.00 per event.
- There are 75 events listed.
- Trappers may apply for each event once annually.
- Application fees are non-refundable.
- Applications must be submitted in the name of an adult.
- Drawings will be held in late October. Applicants will be notified by mid-November by U.S. Mail.
- Trappers chosen to participate may print the permit, along with any special instructions and maps online.
- The permit to trap applies to the successfully drawn applicant and one named assistant. Once chosen the assistant cannot be changed.
- All permitted trappers and assistants must be properly licensed. Beaver Trapping Permits are not transferable.
- Permit is good for beaver and river otter only in those counties open to river otter trapping (see 2011-2012 Hunting and Trapping Regulations for details and bag limits).
- If successful applicant is not able to trap an area, he/she must inform the district office.
