


NOTICE:

- 2 areas of the Deer Creek Wildlife Area as shown below will be closed for aerial spraying of invasive bush honeysuckle on one date between October 17-November 18.
- The specific treatment day will depend on weather conditions. Parking lots adjacent to the treatment areas will be closed the morning of the spray date.
- Bush honeysuckle includes 3 species of shrubs that are not native to the U.S. These non-native shrubs grow vigorously and crowd out native vegetation.
- Aerial spraying is effective in fall because the honeysuckle holds its leaves longer while native trees and shrubs have already gone dormant for the season.
