

# WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Ohio Division of Wildlife and USGS's Lake Erie Biological Station are working on a collaborative tagging effort to understand movement of yellow perch across different management areas.



Adult yellow perch are being tagged with a PIT tag. This tag is about the size of a grain of rice and is similar to identification tags used on some pets. It is impossible to tell if a fish is PIT tagged without scanning it!



For the project's success, we need to scan your perch catch to locate PIT tags. This only takes a few seconds per cooler or fish tote, and we would greatly appreciate your participation. *These fish are safe to consume!*
