


HOOK RESTRICTIONS MAUMEE BAY and SANDUSKY BAY March 1 – May 1



The following regulations are in effect from March 1 – May 1: (1) No fishing with a line with more than a single hook. The line may not have a hook larger than one-half inch from shank to point, or lure having more than a single hook larger than one-half inch from shank to point. (2) Treble hooks are prohibited.

The above regulations are in effect in the following areas: (1) in the Maumee River from the Grand Rapids/Providence Dam to a line in Maumee Bay from Little Cedar Point to Turtle Island. (2) in the Sandusky River from where the power line, "Toledo Edison", Old Ballville and Fifth Street line crosses the Sandusky River at the southwest corner of Roger Young Park, city of Fremont, Sandusky County to a line in Sandusky Bay, one-quarter mile east of the Conrail railroad bridge.

Note: Additional areas include portions of the Portage and Mahoning River. These areas are not noted on this map. Please see the Ohio Fishing Regulations for further details.
