## ODNR Division of Wildlife

**Position:** Conservation Workers

**Pay Rate:** \$13.78 /hr.

**Duration:** Approximately 1,000 hours per year (timeframe **June through December**)

**Duties:** A Conservation Worker is needed to assist in completing a wide array of wildlife management activities and general maintenance activities at several wildlife areas and their satellite properties. Duties include but not limited to grassland management, wetland management, forest-wildlife management, facility maintenance, invasive-plant control, nest structure maintenance, planting food plots, trapping & banding doves and waterfowl. The candidate may also assist in wildlife surveys, fisheries work, controlled hunts, and other duties as assigned. Regular work tasks will require the use of farm tractors, farming implements, UTV's, aerial photos, shop tools, small power tools, sprayers and heavy equipment. This is a full-time seasonal position, not to exceed 1,000 hours in a calendar or fiscal year, and carries no benefits.

**Qualifications:** Applicants must be 18 years or older and possess a valid driver's license. Preference may be given to those with:

- ability to interact with the public & plan ahead, notify supervisor of concerns, etc;
- basic knowledge of wildlife biology or natural resource management through the completion of at least one year (2 semesters) of post-high school education towards a degree in wildlife management or closely related Natural Resources field;
- experience with tools such as chemical sprayers, small power tools & mowers;
- experience in operation of farm equipment and construction equipment;
- available to work varying hours and weekends as needed;
- work hours: 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, varies as assigned based on operational need.
